Here are some key refurbishment elements we need donations for:

£100

could pay for **Google Mini Smart Speakers** for the high-tech zone, voice-controlled speakers that will allow our Squad to play music, control smart gadgets, play videos and more

£500

could go toward **specially adapted seating for our Transition suite**, allowing our Squad to make use of the facilities freely without the need for crane lifts

£1,000

could pay for **acoustic wall panelling for the high-tech zone**, so that the Squad can use it without disturbing others in the Transition suite.

£3,000

could go towards **specialist AV equipment for the high-tech zone**, allowing the Squad to watch films together or do karaoke

£5,000

could pay for **height-adjusting work-tops in the kitchenette zone** that will allow our young adults to independently learn new skills in the kitchen while ensuring we are inclusive to all abilities
