Being Fit for the Future with Tŷ Hafan



Back in November 2019, we were approached by a long term supporter and retired primary head teacher, Colin Skinner, with the idea of a Tŷ Hafan Enterprise Week - the idea being that we approach primary schools across Wales to engage with them in light of our refurbishment appeal and 21st birthday.

Concept

Pupils will take part in an Enterprise Week to try to raise money for Tŷ Hafan.

In a special Monday morning assembly held by the head teacher at the school, the children will be challenged to create a product or service that they can sell at their Friday afternoon market.

Each class or group will receive a maximum loan of £10 from the school and will be asked to use that money buy supplies and turn it into something that can be sold for profit.

Importantly, the pupils will be responsible for their own success. They will have to plan, make and prepare their product, advertise and sell their items.

For example; a group could decide to make bookmarks, so their £10 would be used to buy supplies. After making the bookmarks, they will sell them at the market. They will also create the advertising of their product, work out their finances, promote the market and then sell their product on the Friday afternoon at the end of Enterprise Week.

After the market has closed, the school will get their £10 loan back and the profits will be added up by the children ready to be donated to Tŷ Hafan. The children will be given a certificate to celebrate their success!

Once Enterprise Week has come to an end, schools will be able to send donations to Tŷ Hafan and we'll send a special thank you and certificate for the school to display.



Why Tŷ Hafan?

Tŷ Hafan provides vital 24/7 comfort, care and support to children and young adults across Wales. We give families the chance to make lasting happy memories together, siblings the opportunity to meet and have fun with others in a similar situation to themselves and help children with life-limiting or life-threatening conditions reach their potential.
